Garnett earned a Bachelor's Degree from the University of Kentucky. She worked for more than 25 years as a school teacher. She mainly taught English at Wayne Local Schools in Waynesville and Berry Middle School in Lebanon, ultimately retiring from Lebanon. Over the years, she attended the Methodist church in Waynesville and Florence, Kentucky.

Sweet, caring, easygoing, simple, and occasionally ornery, Garnett loved UK sports, quilting, painting and drawing, and spending time with her grandchildren.
