SHIPLEY, James, age 65, of Beavercreek, passed away on July 24, 2022, at Centerville Health and Rehab.

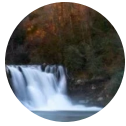

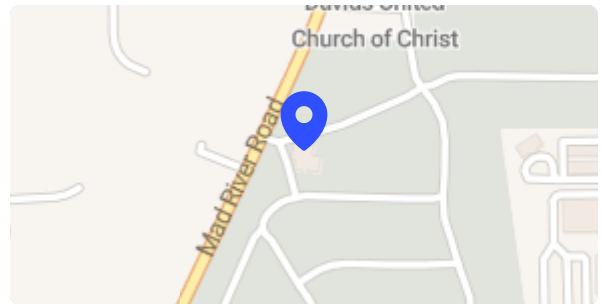


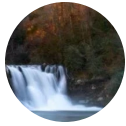
