The Tennessee trip would sometimes turn into a classic Griswold vacation with all the antics and mishaps that often came along, which he found entertaining with the Griswold name. 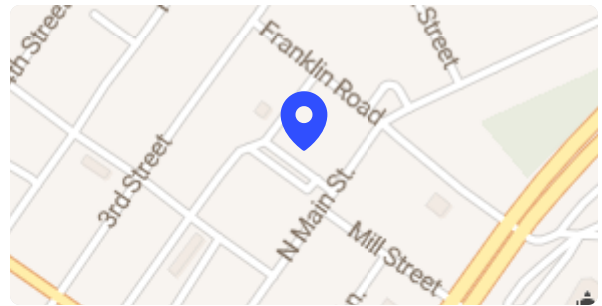

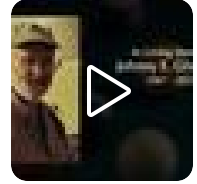
