Betty always enjoyed dancing for fun. As a loving wife to her husband, she lived a life full of love in every aspect. She had a special place in her heart for everyone, especially for her son, Gary. 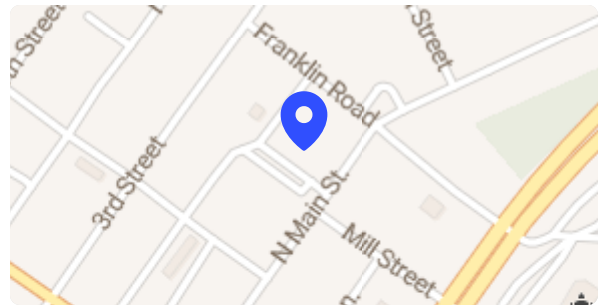

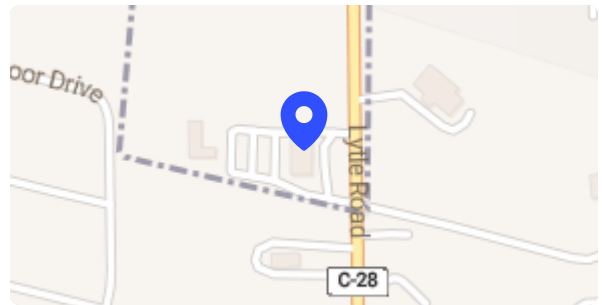

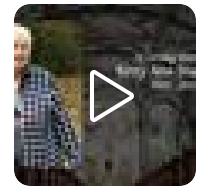
