COOK, John “Sherman” age 91 of Waynesville passed away Sat. Aug. 25, 2007 at Hospice of Dayton. Born Sept. 22, 1915 to John Sherman Sr. and Bessie Cook in Madison Co., KY. Sherman was a WWII Army Veteran. He founded the Full Gospel Tabernacle in 1971 and has continued to faithfully serve until the time of his death. He greatly enjoyed farming in his earlier days, fishing, spending time with grandchildren, and fishing for souls. He was preceded in death by his wife Alene in 2004; one daughter Sharon Rose Cook; four brothers Roy, Brown, Henry, and Thomas A. 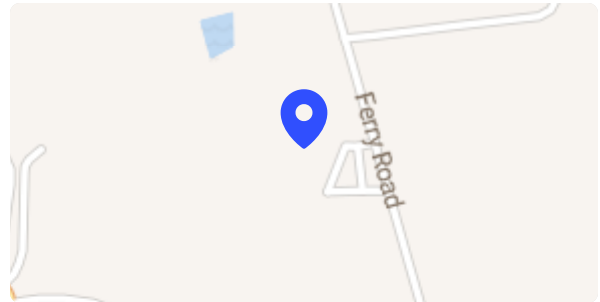

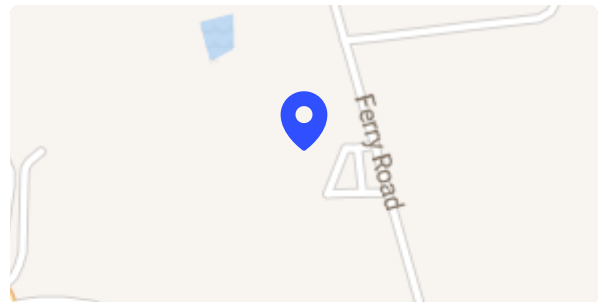
