N. “Alice” Coffman, age 84, of Waynesville, Ohio, passed away on Wednesday, December 10, 2025, at her residence.

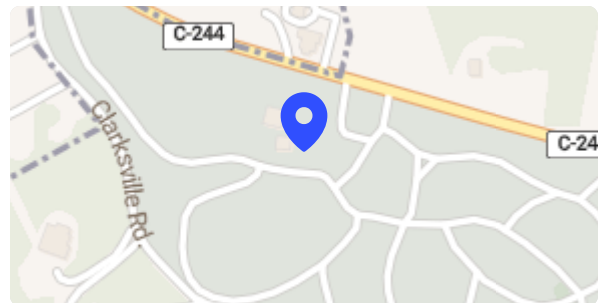

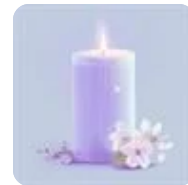
