NELSON, Ann Catherine, age 91 of Waynesville, passed away Sunday, September 8, 2019 at Kettering Medical Center; she was born September 11, 1927 in Youngstown, Ohio. A proud member of the Women's Air Corp (WAC), Ann served in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean Conflict. She retired from DESC/WPAFB in 1989, 35 years service. 
