NOBLE, Beacher age 83, of Lebanon, passed away Fri. Jan. 29, 2016 at his residence. Beacher was a Korean Conflict Navy veteran. He worked 13 years for Crystal Tissue in Middletown and retired from General Electric after more than 25 years of service. Beacher was one of the founding trustees of the Full Gospel Tabernacle in Waynesville. An amazing softball player and overall athlete in his youth, he greatly enjoyed coaching his sons' youth sports teams, hunting, and fishing.
