Among many things, she will be remembered for her insistence on visiting and staying connected with her many direct and extended family members, creating a lifetime of great family memories.

She was preceded in death by her parents Eugene and Nancy; and former husband Art. She is survived by her son Scott (Sandy) Kyle of Cincinnati; three grandchildren Montana, Peyton, and Seth; two sisters Caryl (Powell) Toth of WV and Nancy (David) Liffick of Waynesville; one brother, Eric (Marilyn) Butterbaugh of Waynesville; and several nieces and nephews.


