When her children were young, they created fond memories during the many camping and fishing trips to Rocky Fork Lake and other weekend destinations. Trips to Amish Country in Philadelphia, St. Augustine in Florida and Myrtle Beach in South Carolina will always be remembered as some of the best family memories from years ago. Among many things however, she will be especially remembered for how much she cared for her kids and grandchildren.
