



## Virginia S. Nicely

October 24, 1919 - September 15, 2013

NICELY, Virginia (Scott), age 93 of Kettering, passed away at her residence on Sun, Sept 15. Virginia was a 1938 graduate of Waynesville High School (she had perfect attendance and celebrated her 75th alumni dinner in May 2013). She was a member of Prince of Peace Church of the Brethren for over 55 years and was active with youth programs at church, Girl Scouts, and her daughters' activities in the Kettering City Schools. Virginia worked at Frigidaire until she took on her favorite role of mother and grandmother. Virginia was preceded in death by her husband of 45 years, Phillip Homer in 1987.
